1. Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship

Performance Requirements and Information:

- Open to young flautists aged fifteen years or under on January 1, 2020.
- Entrants are required to perform their own choice of contrasting works on a C Concert Flute.
- Time limit: 8 minutes.
- Entry Fee: \$25
 - First Prize \$250
 - Second Prize \$100 sponsored by Tim Svenson.

2. David Cubbin Memorial Competitions

a) Senior School Solo Performance

Performance Requirements and Information:

- Open to secondary school student flautists aged 16 years to 18 years on October 18, 2020.
- Entrants are required to perform their own choice of contrasting works.
- Time limit: 8-11 minutes.
- Entry fee: \$20
 - First Prize \$200 sponsored by Anon.
 - Second Prize \$50 voucher from Size Music and \$50 sponsored by Karen Fletcher.

b) David Cubbin Memorial Competition

Performance Requirements and Information:

- Open to non-professional flautists aged 18 years to 30 years of age on October 18, 2020.
- Entrants are required to perform their own choice of contrasting works.
- Time limit: 15 minutes.
- Entry fee: \$30
 - First Prize \$500
 - Second Prize \$150 and \$100 voucher from Size Music.

Information for all three Competitions:

- Copies of piano scores must be provided for the adjudicator.
- The time between pieces is not included in the time limit.
- All entrants in The Flute Society of South Australia Competitions must be financial members of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc.
- The APRA/AMCOS Copyright Declaration Form must be completed and sent with the Entry Form.

CAROLYN WHITE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP RULES

(David Cubbin Memorial Competitions Rules on reverse side)

1. Entrants must be fifteen years or under on January 1, 2020. A parent or guardian is required to verify the entrant's age by signing the entry form.
2. The entrant must be or must become a financial member of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. Current financial members are issued with a white membership card stating that their membership of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. expires on December 31, 2020 or June 30, 2021.
3. The Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
4. Previous First Prize Winners of the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship are not eligible to enter.
5. All performances presented at the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship must be given on a C Concert Flute.
6. The winners will be announced by the adjudicator at the end of the scholarship on either Sunday October 18 or Sunday October 25, 2020. All entrants will receive a written report. The adjudicator's decisions will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, an adjudicator is unable to perform his/her duties, The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. reserves the right to appoint a substitute adjudicator without notice.
8. The entry fee is payable at the time of an entry being lodged and is not refundable.
9. Late entries are not accepted.
10. Competitors must provide their own accompanist at their own expense.
11. Entrants must use the original music on stage during the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship, unless a work is out of copyright or official authorisation to use a photocopy has been obtained from the publisher or composer. Competitors are required to complete and return APRA/AMCOS Copyright Declaration Form, 1, 'Performer's Declaration', with the Entry Form. The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. will not be liable for any copyright infringement related to the submission or use of photocopies.
12. Competitors must provide legible piano score copies of their own choice pieces for the adjudicator. Photocopies may be used for this purpose but will be retained and destroyed by the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship Committee after use. Competitors are required to complete and return APRA/AMCOS Copyright Declaration Form, 2, 'Making a temporary copy for an adjudicator or examiner' and 3, 'Making a temporary copy for an accompanist', with the Entry Form.
13. All competitors are required to book in no later than 20 minutes before the advertised starting time of the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship and to stay for the duration of the event.
14. The Flute Society of South Australia's Committee reserves the right to cancel the Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship if there are less than six entries. Entries are due by Friday September 18, 2020 and notification to cancel the Scholarship will be given by Friday September 25, 2020.

DAVID CUBBIN MEMORIAL COMPETITIONS RULES

(Carolyn White Memorial Scholarship Rules on reverse side)

1. The David Cubbin Memorial Competitions are open to South Australian residents only.
2. Each entrant must be a financial member of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. As a current financial member you must hold a white membership card stating that your membership of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. expires on December 31, 2020 or June 30, 2021.
3. The David Cubbin Memorial Competitions are open to non-professional flautists in these two categories: Senior School Flute Solo, flautists aged 16 years to 18 years; and David Cubbin Memorial Competition, flautists aged 18 years to 30 years. The ages for both competitions are as of October 18, 2020. A professional is defined as a person who earns the major part of his/her income from flute performance.
4. The Flute Society Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
5. Previous First Prize Winners are not eligible to enter.
6. The Adjudicator's decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, an adjudicator is unable to perform his/her duties, The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. reserves the right to appoint a substitute adjudicator without notice.
8. The entry fees of \$20 for the Senior School Solo and \$30 for the David Cubbin Memorial Competition are payable at the time of an entry being lodged and are not refundable.
9. Prizes may be withheld or reduced where standards are not met. Such a decision shall be made by the adjudicator and an office bearer of The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. This decision will be final.
10. Competitors must provide their own accompanist at their own expense.
11. Entrants must use the original music on stage during the David Cubbin Memorial Competitions unless a work is out of copyright or official authorisation to use a photocopy has been obtained from the publisher or composer. Competitors are required to complete and return APRA/AMCOS Copyright Declaration Form, 1, 'Performer's Declaration', with the Entry Form. The Flute Society of South Australia Inc. will not be liable for any copyright infringement related to the submission or use of photocopies.
12. Competitors must provide a legible piano score copy of their own choice piece(s) for the adjudicator. A photocopy may be used for this purpose but will be retained and destroyed by the David Cubbin Memorial Competitions Committee after use. Competitors are required to complete and return APRA/AMCOS Copyright Declaration Form, 2, 'Making a temporary copy for an adjudicator or examiner' and 3, 'Making a temporary copy for an accompanist', with the Entry Form.
13. The Flute Society of South Australia's Committee reserves the right to cancel either or both of the David Cubbin Memorial Competitions if there are less than six entries. Entries are due by Friday September 18, 2020 and any notifications to cancel will be given by Friday September 25, 2020.
